In the table below you will see that there are three phases for the return to school next term. During all three phases school transport will run as usual. Phase 2 From 11- 15 January	Children of key workers. Children who have been asked by school to come in.	You will be in school at your normal times.	Online learning will be happening in your own school. A member of school staff will support you. You will be doing learning tasks that have been set for you by your teacher(s). Handwashing, distancing and face coverings will still be important.	Everything you usually bring on a school day. Your most positive self.
All other pupils will be at home doing learning tasks that have been set for you by your teacher(s).				

Phase 3

Monday 18 January onwards	Everyone.	You will be in school at your normal times.	School will be open in the usual way and at the usual times, as it was before the holidays. Handwashing, distancing and face coverings will still be important.	Everything you usually bring on a school day. Your most positive self.
