On Friday 19th March we will talk about Red Nose Day and discuss what it is all about.

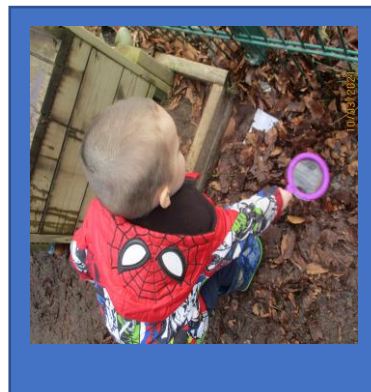
Next Week
